The Nicholas Taylor Winegardner Scholarship Fund was established in 1995 in honor of Nicholas Taylor Winegardner after he lost life in a tragic accident. As a young man in the Newark community, Winegardner participated in numerous glass blowing and hot shop activities at The Works and thoroughly enjoyed working with glass and creating new works of art. After his untimely death, his parents established the scholarship to give back to the community by providing a way for individuals who could not financially afford to participate in glass blowing activities the chance to do so.

Hot Shop Scholarships are awarded to applicants with a strong interest in glass blowing who would like to gain a deeper understanding of the process through hands-on classes and camps at The Works.
